Davos, Switzerland

Boasting the largest ski resort in Switzerland and the highest city in Europe, Davos is comprised of five separate ski areas, any one of which would be considered big by American standards. Davos skiing offers the alpine skier an endless amount of terrain. The ski area is split across two different sides of the Swiss Alps. The Parsenn and Madrisa on one side, Pischa, Jakobshorn and Rinerhorn on the other side, totaling over 200 miles of guaranteed snow-covered pistes. The Glacier Express, a scenic train ride, connects Davos to St. Moritz and the Matterhorn in Zermatt.

Nice, France

Located in the French Riviera, on the south east coast of France on the Mediterranean Sea, at the foot of the Alps, Nice is the second-largest French city on the Mediterranean coast and the second-largest city in the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur region after Marseille.
